Format: Scramble-style (perfect for all us hackers)

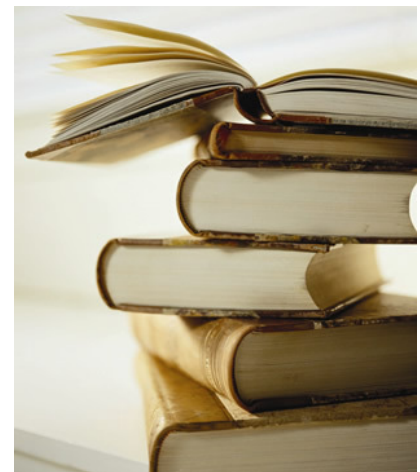
Most common sound heard during the round: The "WHACK" of golf ball on wood.
