## ... fuel for the boiler

### **Fuel for the Boiler**

If you've been around the last couple of years you know that the first cold Sunday of the fall can be just that – a very cold Sunday – inside the church (administrator's preference notwithstanding). This is because our boiler, which is more than 50 years old, is on its last legs. Abe Thiessen and the facilities crew have babied this one along much farther than is normal. It's time to bite the bullet and replace it.

A new one will bring a huge increase in efficiency but the price tag is not small. It will cost \$35,000 - \$40,000 for the replacement. This is too much to add to the budget so we are having a special project starting immediately to raise funds so we can replace the boiler before this winter. We need you to make donations to the **"Fuel for the Boiler"** project in the next few months in order that we can be done in time. Please make your offering, over and above

your regular tithing, as soon as you can and let's get this project done before fall. There are a lot of programs this winter that are depending on that boiler.
